Taikisha has identified “Climate Change Mitigation and Adaption” as one of the key management issues (materiality) to be tackled on a priority basis, and is working to reduce its environmental impact through its core business of providing air-conditioning and sanitary facilities and paint finishing plants with high energy-saving performance.

Taikisha has always taken seriously the fact that climate change-related risks and revenue opportunities would have a significant impact on Taikisha Group’s business activities, earnings, and other factors. Going forward, Taikisha will collect and analyze necessary data, examine the impact, and carry out disclosure in line with the TCFD framework, targeting by April 2023. After that, Taikisha will continue to enhance the quality and quantity of these disclosures.
